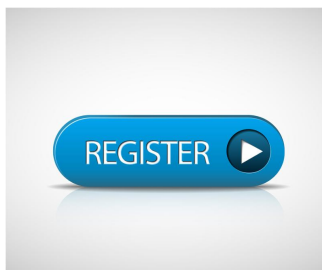

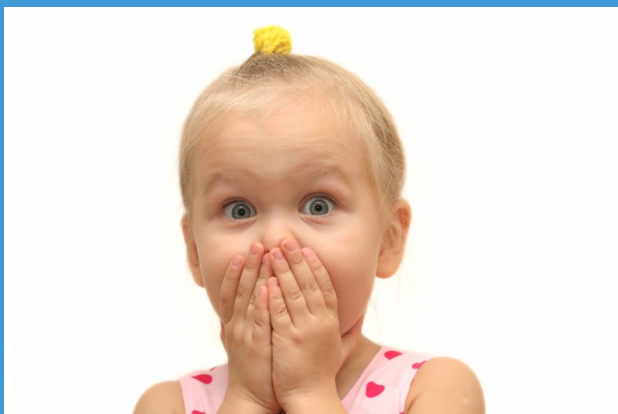
Making and Tinkering With STEM
