Process for TXAEYC Governing Board Appointments

As a membership association governed by an elected board, TXAEYC is committed to diverse leadership on the Governing Board. The slate for upcoming Presidential appointments will be identified by the Nominating Committee. Candidates are chosen to reflect broad knowledge and awareness of the issues facing the education of early learners. They are selected for their ability to objectively consider the variety of perspectives inherent in decisions affecting the Association's future, not to represent a group, region, or interest.

The application asks for general contact and demographic information along with a brief resume and personal statement. Follow these guidelines:

- **Resume:** include employment and experience that is related to the position of which you would like to be considered.
- **References:** 1 personal and 1 professional reference. Include their contact information.
- **Please note:** Current TXAEYC staff members may not serve as references.

Determination of Appointees

Members of the Nominating Committee will review all submitted application materials and references. Once a group of potential candidates are identified, those selected individuals will be invited to interview with the President prior/during the summer board meeting. For the interviews (attendance is mandatory for consideration of appointment). When the President has selected the appointments, he/she will present the appointments to the Board for final approval.

All potential members of the proposed slate are required to submit or give authorization for a criminal background check and sexual offender registry check by signing appropriate authorizations and consents.
