





Membership Levels





Demographics





Each strategic initiative provides recognition opportunities for the funding partner. Additionally, for funding a strategic initiative, you will receive partnership points which can be used toward engagement opportunities with our members throughout the year or at conference.

PROMOTING THE VALUE OF ECE

Early Childhood Day at the Capitol (\$8,000)

Each legislative session, TXAEYC hosts Early Childhood Day at the Capitol to raise awareness of the importance of early childhood education. Early childhood professionals from all over the state join together to meet with their elected officials, attend legislative briefings, and learn more about the legislative process. Funding partner will receive recognition on all event related emails, social media posts, and on-site signage as well as on opportunity to address attendees + 70 partnership points.

TXAEYC Policy Fellow (\$15,000)

Advancing our policy agenda requires TXAEYC to be equipped with the latest research and bill analyses as well as to keep our members abreast on opportunities to be involved in the legislative process. To help accomplish this, TXAEYC will host a graduate policy fellow during the 2022-2023 school year to support the organization's public policy and advocacy efforts. Funding partner will receive recognition on all research and policy briefs produced by TXAEYC for the 88th Legislative Session + 150 partnership points.

Week of the Young Child (\$5,000)

This annual celebration provides the perfect opportunity to deepen families' and communities' understanding of the value of high-quality early childhood education through social media campaigns, community events, and family facing materials. Funding partner will receive recognition on all emails and social media posts related to WOYC + 50 partnership points.

ENSURING ACCESS & QUALITY

NAEYC Accreditation Fee Support Grants (\$10,000)

All young children deserve access to high-quality early learning programs! To support early learning programs in achieving NAEYC Accreditation, TXAEYC will provide grants to cover the cost of fees associated with accreditation. Priority will be given to early learning programs serving children living in poverty, multilingual children, children of color, and children with differing abilities. Funding partner will receive recognition on emails and social media posts promoting grant applications and on all grant application and award materials + 100 partnership points.

NAEYC Accreditation Bootcamp Underwriter (\$5,000)

TXAEYC is launching a two-day NAEYC Accreditation Bootcamp which will guide early learning program leaders through understanding the accreditation standards and process. This new offering by TXAEYC will support early learning programs across the state in increasing their quality so more young children have access to quality programs. Funding partner will receive recognition on emails and social media posts promoting registration + 50 partnership points.

ADVANCING THE PROFESSION

President's Trust Fund (\$5,000)

Access to professional development is key to helping early childhood professionals excel in the field! The President's Trust Fund covers travel expenses and conference registration for TXAEYC members who have never attended our Annual Conference. Funder will receive recognition on all emails and social media posts related to President's Trust Fund + 50 partnership points.

Karen & Gordan Bacon Award (\$2,000)

To honor the legacy of Karen & Gordan Bacon, who were instrumental in securing funding for the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood Texas program, a current or past T.E.A.C.H. recipient is awarded each year with travel funds and complimentary conference registration to attend the TXAEYC Annual Conference. Funding partner will receive recognition on all emails and social media posts related to this award + 20 partnership points.

PRACTICING AND PROMOTING EQUITY

Advocacy Stipends (\$10,000)

TXAEYC is eliminating financial barriers to participating in the legislative process by providing members with stipends to cover travel and unpaid time-off so they can meet with elected officials and participate in legislative hearings. Funding partner will receive recognition in all emails and social media posts related to advocacy stipends + 100 partnership points.

Spanish Translations (\$10,000)

TXAEYC seeks to be an inclusive organization where all early childhood professionals feel that they belong. During 2022-2023, TXAEYC will translate our website and program materials into Spanish to support greater access to membership and programs for individuals who's primary language is Spanish. Funding partner will receive recognition in the footer of translated webpages on TXAEYC's website for one year + 100 partnership points.

INCREASING RECONGITION OF TXEAYC

New TXAEYC Website (\$10,000)

The scope of TXAEYC's programming and resources has grown significantly. To facilitate greater access to our programs and resources, TXAEYC is overhauling our website with early childhood professionals in mind, ensuring they can easily learn about all of our offerings and take full advantage of them. Funding partner will receive recognition in the footer of all pages on the new website for one year + 100 partnership points.

EQUIPPING THE ORGANIZATION

New CRM Platform (\$10,000)

Serving our members and the early childhood field effectively requires us to harness the power of technology so we can deliver the most current and relevant information to the correct audiences. As TXAEYC has grown, we have identified the need for a CRM platform to support us in more meaningful engagement with those we serve. Funding partner will receive recognition in the footer of all marketing emails sent through the CRM for one year + 100 partnership points.

Keynote Sponsor (\$5,000)

The TXAEYC 2022 Annual Conference features keynote speakers on Friday and Saturday mornings. Keynote Sponsors receive recognition during the introduction of the keynote session. There are two keynote sponsorship opportunities + 20 sponsorship points

President's Reception (\$10,000)

Known to be a highlight of the conference, all conference attendees are invited to the President's Reception to enjoy a night of food, drinks, and dancing. The reception sponsor will have an opportunity to address attendees at the President's Reception + 40 sponsorship points.

Exhibitor Happy Hour (\$5,000)

At the end of the first day of conference, the exhibit hall is bustling as attendees enjoy light snacks while connecting with exhibitors. Happy Hour sponsor will receive recognition on signage at snack stations + 20 sponsorship points.
